The Monday and Wednesday morning leagues are going ahead as planned starting week commencing 13 May and rink fees are £5.

Adam Fuller, our Men's Vice Captain will be co-ordinating and managing one or two teams in the Fantastic Fives Summer League competition which is run by the EIBA and we hope to field some strong teams. The format for this is as follows

- games are of 12 ends of singles, eight ends of Fours followed by 10 ends of three wood pairs and 10 ends of two wood triples.
- Two points for a win and one for a draw in each discipline.

There are also other EIBA Summer National Competitions which are available, entry is direct through their website.

It goes without saying that the club remains open all summer for casual bowling if you fancy a roll up.
